HEALTHCARE AND HIGHER EDUCATION EXPERIENCE: Leslie was the Chief Operating Officer of College Hospital, a psychiatric hospital with a \$16 million operating budget and over 300 employees in Cerritos, CA. In that capacity, she supervised the management team and participated in developing and implementing the mission, the strategic plan and therapeutic programs. She was also the Director of a Special Care Unit for the Jewish Home for the Aging, where she provided administrative oversight of a 124 bed Alzheimer's unit. In one instance, she planned and completed the relocation of 47 residents occupying an earthquake-damaged building, still managing to reduce that year's operating budget by ten percent. Leslie has been a lecturer in Organizational Development for Loyola Marymount University and Immaculate Heart College.

NONPROFIT PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE: Leslie has had a distinguished career in the nonprofit sector, having served as Executive Director of Temple Beth Hillel and as Director of Program Development for The H.E.L.P. Group. In these positions, she gained an in depth understanding of nonprofit operations, having supervised volunteer programs, held responsibility for compliance with regulatory agencies and overseen the fiscal integrity of organizations and financial reports.
