

Board Development and Organizational Development



Despite a successful program year helping more than 800 at-risk youth develop their gifts and talents, Board Chair Amy Bawden and the Youth Mentoring Connection (YMC) leadership found themselves at a difficult crossroads. Demand for their mentoring services was at all-time high, but some funders were concerned about YMC's overall sustainability and denied their grant requests. Thankfully, YMC was able to take advantage of a capacity-building

grant from The Ahmanson Foundation, and, in March 2017, Amy and her board, along with YMC staff, teamed up with ESC to build the financial infrastructure YMC needed to survive. The year-long project seemed daunting at first, but with the support of their ESC consultants, the YMC board and staff remained committed. Together, they developed a targeted messaging strategy for funders, explored strategies to create a social enterprise and invested in their board infrastructure. Now, funders are increasing their grants, and new partners are emerging. YMC is poised to scale their services and bring their mentoring programs to more youth for years to come.

Developing Development Program and Customized Leadership Coaching









Inspired by the direction of their new strategic plan, President and CEO Rigo Saborio and St. Barnabas Senior Services (SBSS) were determined to do more to help the growing population of vulnerable older adults in Los Angeles. They

had a vision to empower this community to live and age well. In order to build the infrastructure needed to scale their care services to reach 20,000 older adults per year by 2020, Rigo enrolled his board and staff in ESC's 2016-2017 Developing Development Program, where they learned to create effective new fundraising strategies to sustain their programs. These efforts demanded stronger leadership across SBSS, so Rigo worked with ESC in 2017 to design a custom coaching program for directors and emerging leaders at the organization. With the guidance of ESC consultants, participating staff members tackled challenges and grew more confident in their leadership skills, which helped form a more cohesive team across the entire organization. Today, the SBSS staff is energized to tackle their mission together and help older adults age with dignity and respect.
